
Let's see who will conquer the most flags as the 25-time Stratego World Champion and make Stratego history.

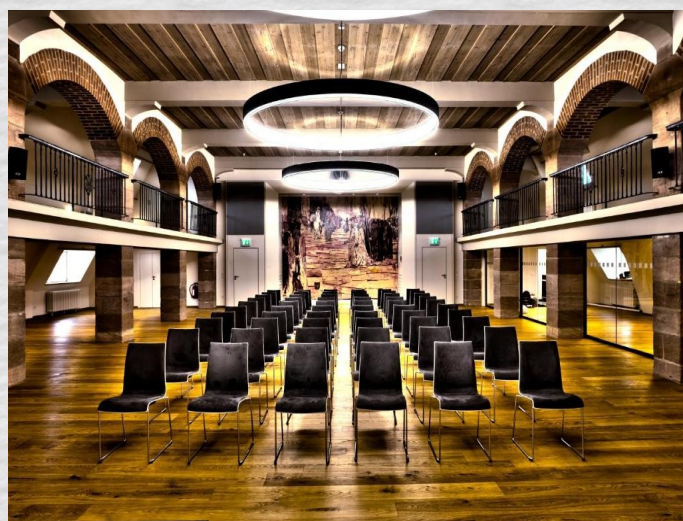


## Playing venue

The Stratego World Championship will be held right in the heart of Nuremberg, in one of the most beautiful youth hostels in the world. Where hundreds of years ago knights lived and guarded the castle, today a modern center equipped with all technical means has been created, which has perfectly implemented the synthesis between historical origin and modernity.

From our youth hostel, you can reach the center of Nuremberg in just 5 minutes on foot. Here you can visit the beautiful City with nice shopping centers. Or how about a historical stroll through the city?

Nuremberg has been well known for its toys for more than 600 years. Its tradition goes back to medieval doll makers and ranges forward through outstanding makers of pewter figurines and the numerous tin toy makers of the industrial era, all the way to today's International Toy Fair, the world's most important trade show of its kind.

Barrage is the short version of Stratego, both players get 8 pieces:

(1x Marshal. 1x General. 1x Miner. 2x Scout. 1x Spy. 1x Bomb. 1x Flag)

Classic is the version everyone knows so well, both players get full armies of 40 pieces.

## Regulations for non-standard events

## WC Barrage

During the WC Barrage, players who are matched up against each other will play two games. In case the first game is finished before all other players have finished their match, they should wait in order to keep the clock synchronized.

Each game of a match is scored individually using regular scoring (6-3-1). If you win two games against the same opponent during a match, the score would be 12-2. If you were to draw twice against the same opponent during a match, the score would be 6-6. A loss and a draw would get you 7-7.

## WC Country teams

A country team consists of four players fulfilling the requirements as outlawed by the ISF rules & regulations. In case a country only has three players but does participate in the WC Country teams, they forfeit the 4th board.

Priority is decided by finishing place during the WC Classic Event. In case a player declines, the next in line can enter.

In case a country does not have enough players to be eligible to enter (3 or more) the WC Country teams competition but does have a player, who despite not having participated in the WC Classic event, that fulfils all requirement, they may enter this player instead. Priority still goes to those who did participate during the WC Classic event.

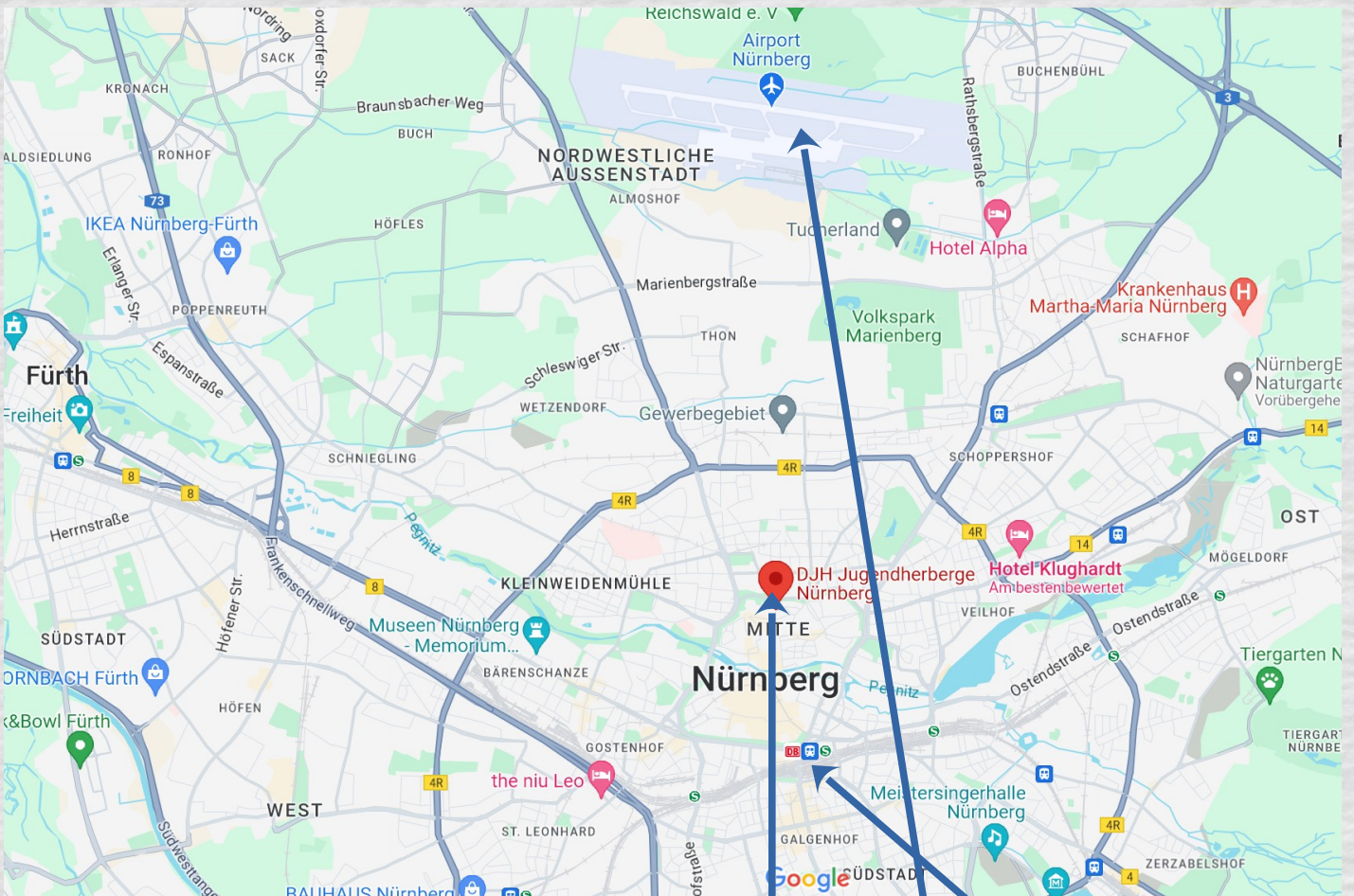

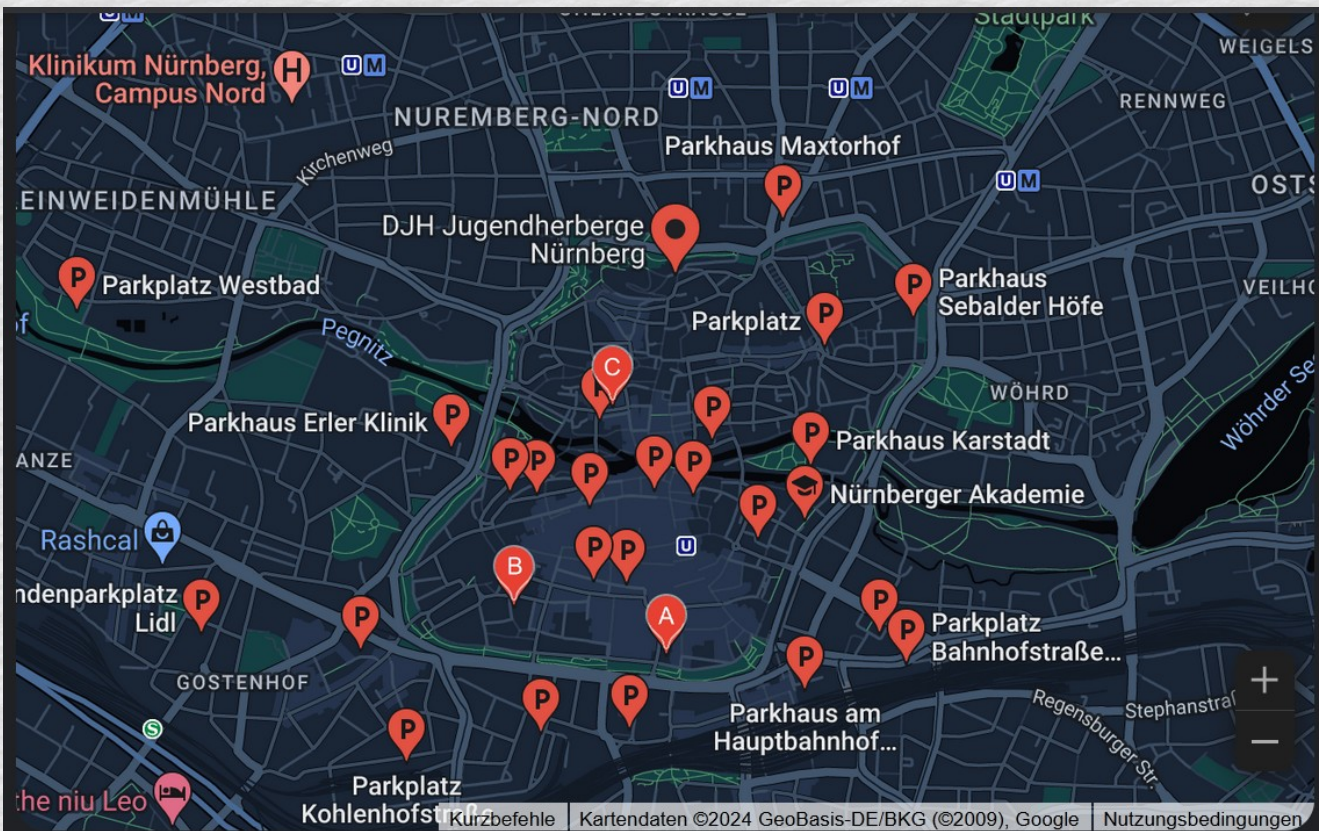
